

Massachusetts Avenue Reconstruction

Massachusetts Avenue is a major north-south arterial passing through the Back Bay and South End districts of Boston. The corridor services widely varying land uses such as Symphony Hall, Horticultural Hall, Northeastern University, the Christian Science Center and Boston City Hospital and passes through four historic districts.

Greenman-Pedersen, Inc. (GPI) is currently providing design services for the reconstruction of one mile of Massachusetts Avenue from Albany Street to Westland Avenue. Work includes roadway reconstruction, geometric improvements, drainage, sidewalks, vault/areaway elimination and the optimization, timing and coordination of eight signalized intersections. Extensive landscape architecture and urban design including period lighting is also required for this highly visible project.

Base mapping has been prepared utilizing aerial photogrammetry supplemented with ground survey.
