
Eastern Associated Terminals Environmental Permit Compliance Services



Regulatory Agency Liaison

Client/Owner: Eastern Associated Terminals

Project Location: Tampa, Florida

GPI provides regulatory liaison services, stormwater pollution prevention planning, and permit compliance oversight for Eastern Associated Terminals, located on East Bay in the Port of Tampa. The facility is a Title V and NPDES Multi-Sector Generic permittee. Services include permit re-applications and regulatory negotiations, compliance reporting and inspection coordination. Pollution prevention planning by GPI staff included development of “A Plan for Facility Assessment & Developing Abatement Alternatives”. As part of the assessment, GPI developed a watershed model for the industrial facility using the modified SCS procedure, model runoff and pollutant loading. GPI applied the model results to determine source identification by sub-basin and to prioritize implementation of BMPs for pollutant loading reductions. Permit compliance oversight included QA/QC of the facility’s existing water quality monitoring program and Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan, resulting in equipment upgrades, protocol modifications, and in-house training to improve accuracy and usefulness of monitoring and reporting activities.
