On Saturday, April 25th, GPI's Rockville branch along with other members of the Washington Building Congress (WBC) participated in Rebuilding Together, a national, non-profit organization devoted to rebuilding communities and preserving affordable housing. GPI participates in other charitable organizations throughout the year including Operation Sugarplum, Miriam's Kitchen, and Special Olympics.

A member of WBC's Community Services Committee, Winona Leaman, nominated House Captain for the second consecutive year, organized an overwhelmingly generous team of more than 60 volunteers, representing

18 firms. Because of the scope of work involved in this year's home, many tasks were started prior to the actual project day. The interior of the house was completely repainted, all windows were replaced, hardwood floors were refinished, the bathroom was renovated, insulation was installed in crawl spaces and the attic, new siding and gutters were installed, and landscaping was done.
