CCC&L/GPI TRAINING CLASSES

The Basics of Coatings, Application & Inspection

Length:	3 Days
Description:	The course is designed to teach inspection procedures and the reasons for the inspection requirements. Therefore a significant part of the time is spent discussing the basics of coatings materials, surface preparation, coating application, and field procedures. Specifications and inspection reports are also reviewed. The course is taught using a combination of lectures, discussions, and student participation. Unique experiments developed by CCC&L are used to demonstrate and visualize important concepts. Each participant will have the opportunity to use common inspection instruments under the guidance of the instructors. Successful completion of this course meets the training requirements of a Quality Control Supervisor for SSPC-QP1 certification.
Intended Audience:	This course is designed for owner personnel involved in planning, specifying, and executing coatings projects; coatings manufacturers technical services and sales personnel; contractors; and inspectors.

Quality Control Procedures and Inspection Instruments

Length:	1 Day
Description:	The course is designed to teach inspection procedures to someone familiar with coatings. The common inspection procedures are presented with emphasis on why the inspection is performed, how it is performed, when it is performed, and how many measurements are to be made. Each participant will be given the opportunity to use common inspection instruments under the guidance of the instructor. Bring your own instruments and the instructor will assist in making sure you are using it correctly.
Intended Audience:	Contractor QC personnel, inspectors, engineers.

Maintenance and Protection of Traffic (MOT/MPT)

Length:	1 Day
Description:	The course is designed to inform the participants of the requirements of proper Temporary Traffic Control (TTC) as required by the National Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD). It provides instruction in the parts of a temporary traffic control zone, the requirements for installation and removal and the proper methods of achieving them. It covers both stationary and mobile TTC. It also instructs the participant in the requirements of flagging and how to recognize the proper method of flagging. Participants will use a tabletop demonstration to provide their solutions to some common TTC problems.
Intended Audience:	Contractors, utilities, owners, engineers, inspectors and others responsible for inspecting and, or installing Temporary Traffic Control at construction, maintenance and, or utility work zones.

SSPC C3: Supervisor/Competent Person Training for Deleading of Industrial Structures

Length:	4 Days
Description:	C-3 includes background information on the hazards of lead and other toxic metals as well as the current legal and regulatory environment. The course contains specific discussions on protecting workers; compliance with environmental regulations; proper management of waste streams and operations that result in potential exposures to lead; and associated control technology. The course also addresses reading specifications and developing programs to effectively control risks to workers, the public, and the environment. It concludes with a discussion of insurance and bonding issues, and an introduction to other safety and health issues that are encountered on painting projects.
Intended Audience:	Those assigned competent-person duties on any industrial deleading project; coatings inspectors who document contractor compliance; project managers and coating specifiers; containment superintendents; design engineers. * The C-3 Course meets the competent person training requirements for SSPC QP-2 Contractor Certification.

SSPC C5: Supervisor/Competent Person Lead Refresher Course

Length:	1 Day
Description:	This one-day course provides refresher training for supervisors/competent persons who are responsible for industrial deleading operations. It starts with a review of basic information about lead and the human health hazards associated with it. The course continues with a review and update of relevant EPA regulations and progresses through discussions of 29 CFR 1926.62 and changes in the Respiratory Protection Standard (29 CFR 1910.134). C5 concludes with discussions about control over emissions as presented in SSPC Guide 6.
Intended Audience:	Those assigned competent-person duties on any industrial deleading project who need a refresher; coatings inspectors who document contractor compliance; project managers and coating specifiers; containment superintendents; design engineers. * The C-5 Course meets the competent person refresher training requirements for SSPC QP-2 Contractor Certification.
Cost:	\$255.00. MD, VA, IL, MO and NJ Supplements are available for \$25/student
